Spirit Gifted and Empowered Service:

We are committed to training and nurturing disciples to holy living and understanding their spiritual gifts so they are equipped and effective in using those gifts in ministry. [Romans 12; 1 Corinthians 12-14; Ephesians 4:11-5:21]
